Why EMERGE ?

Migration is a key determinant to real church growth in Australia (Hughes et al, cited in Menzies 2017); and most church growth regardless of the religion or denomination, is related to migration. It is argued that the motives for this growth include the desire for immigrants to connect and experience community.

EMERGE provides a vehicle to engage with the migrant people and platforms.
